A private villa on one of the last pristine stretches of the Lombok coast, a resort that begins at your front door and an island that opens up the moment you are ready for it. Reefs metres from the sand, the Secret Gilis before breakfast, a volcano on the horizon and a culture that has carried on, unhurried, for centuries. Everything Lombok has kept quietly to itself, now part of everyday life.

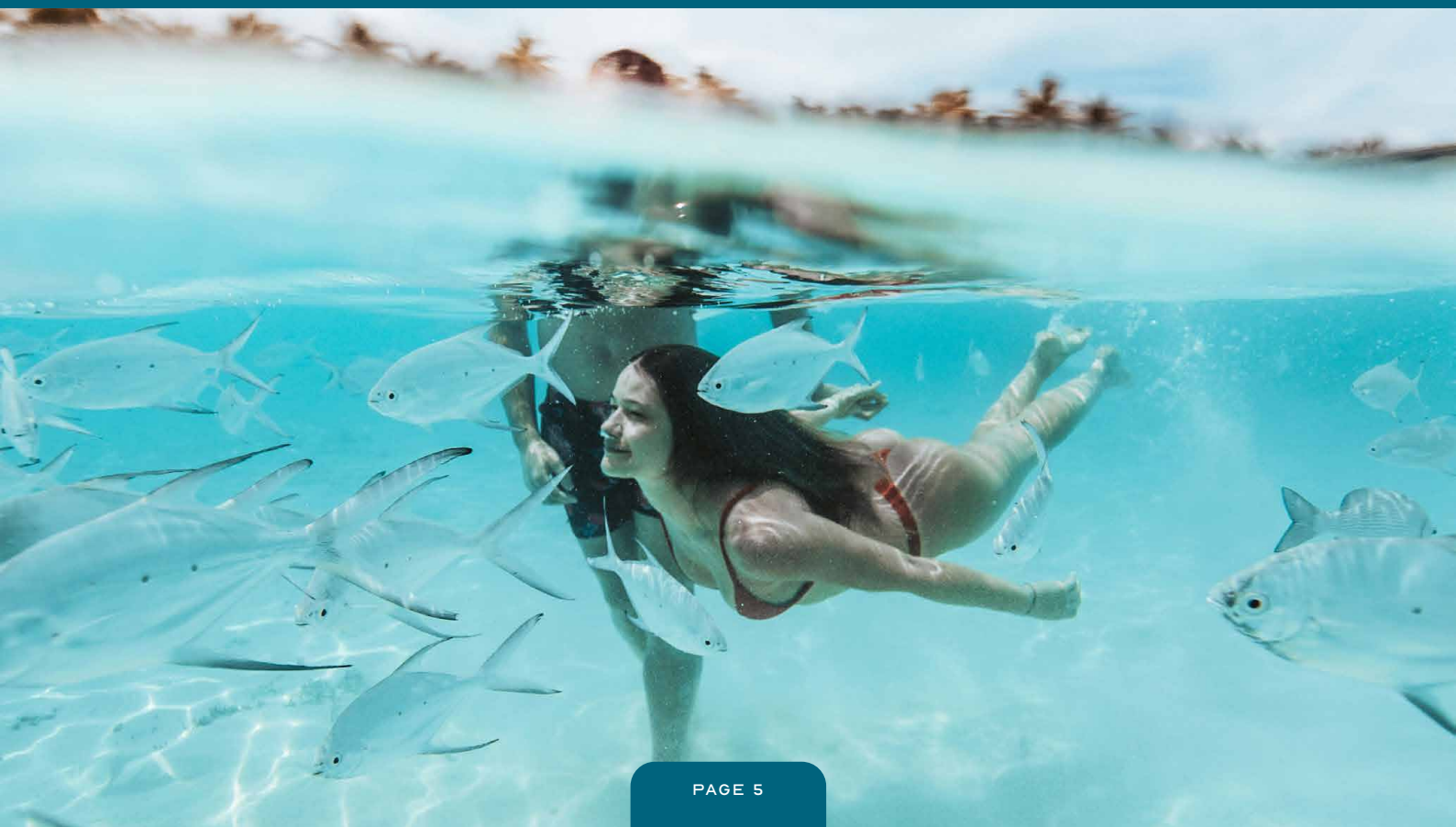

Tropical Reefs & Year-round Diving.

SOME OF INDONESIA'S FINEST REEFS
BEGIN AT THE END OF YOUR BEACH.

The water directly off Saraya is alive. Coral gardens start just metres from the sand, close enough to reach with a mask and fins before breakfast. Sea turtles are a near-daily encounter, reef sharks patrol the drop-offs and visibility holds clear and warm through every season. Beyond the bay, the island opens up. The reefs around the Secret Gilis, the outer dive sites across the strait and the coral walls of Sekotong are all within easy reach by boat. Guided, equipped and arranged through the resort whenever the day calls for it.



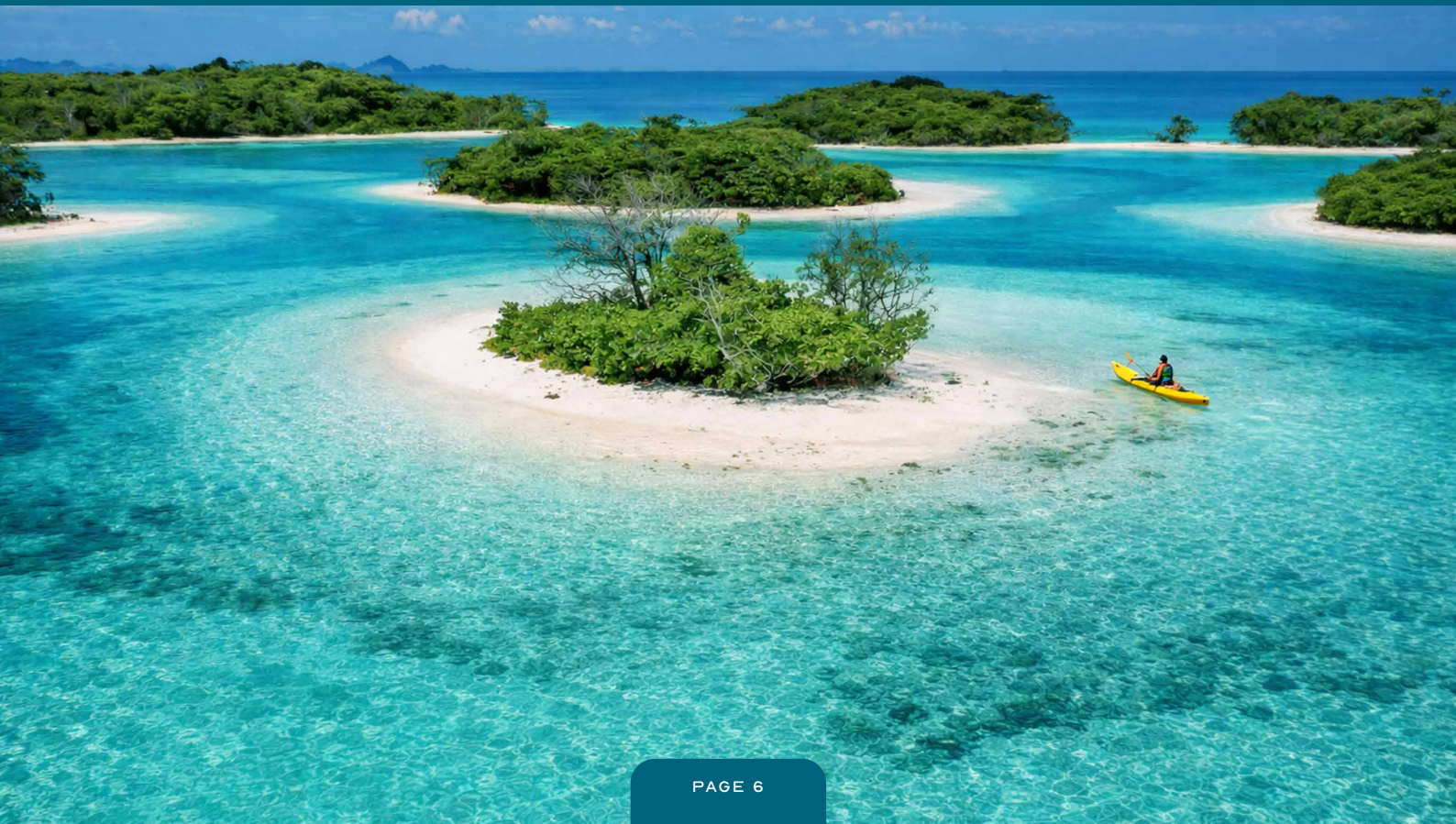


Island Hopping The Secret Islands.

A SHORT BOAT TRIP FROM OUR RESORT.

The Secret Gilis lie almost directly off Saraya. Nanggu, Sudak and Kedis, tiny and undeveloped and ringed with clear water, close enough to reach before breakfast and circle on foot in minutes. Anchor off a deserted sandbar, snorkel straight from the boat then drift back as the light softens over the strait.

Further out, Gili Trawangan, Meno and Air deliver three of the most celebrated small islands in the country. A private charter puts all of it within reach. Your itinerary, your pace, a half day or a full one on water that feels entirely your own.



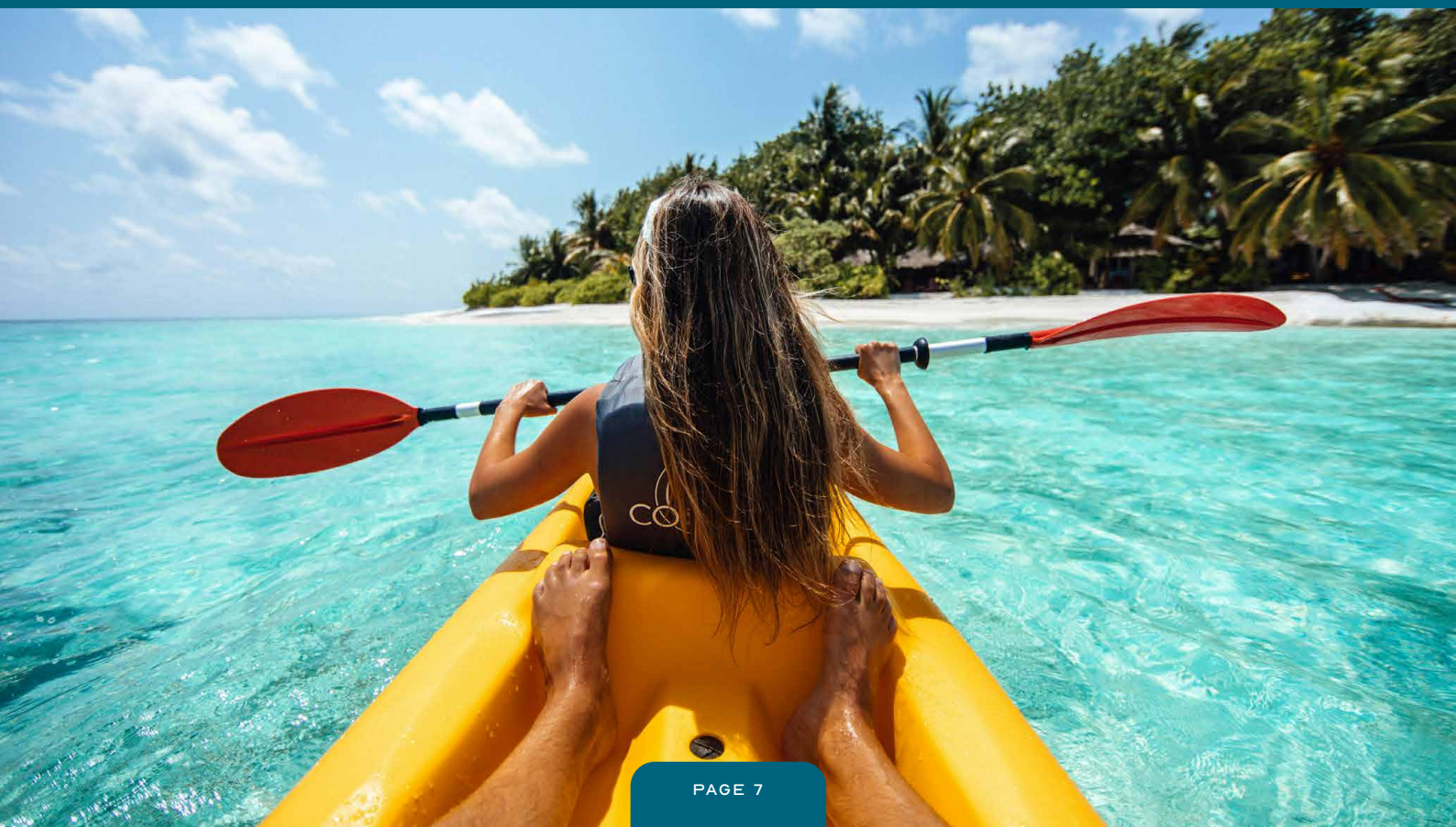


Watersports Straight Off The Beach.

WARM, CALM AND PROTECTED, THE BAY IS
BUILT FOR TIME ON THE WATER.

The bay at Saraya is sheltered enough to make every kind of water day easy. Step off the beach onto a paddleboard at first light, glide across glassy water before the heat arrives or push out by kayak to explore the coastline at your own pace. The water is warm year round, the surface mostly calm and the whole bay sits a few steps from your villa.

When the mood shifts faster, jet skis and banana boats bring the energy. For everyone else there is the simplest pleasure of all. A long swim in some of the clearest water in the region, with the reef below and the headlands all around.

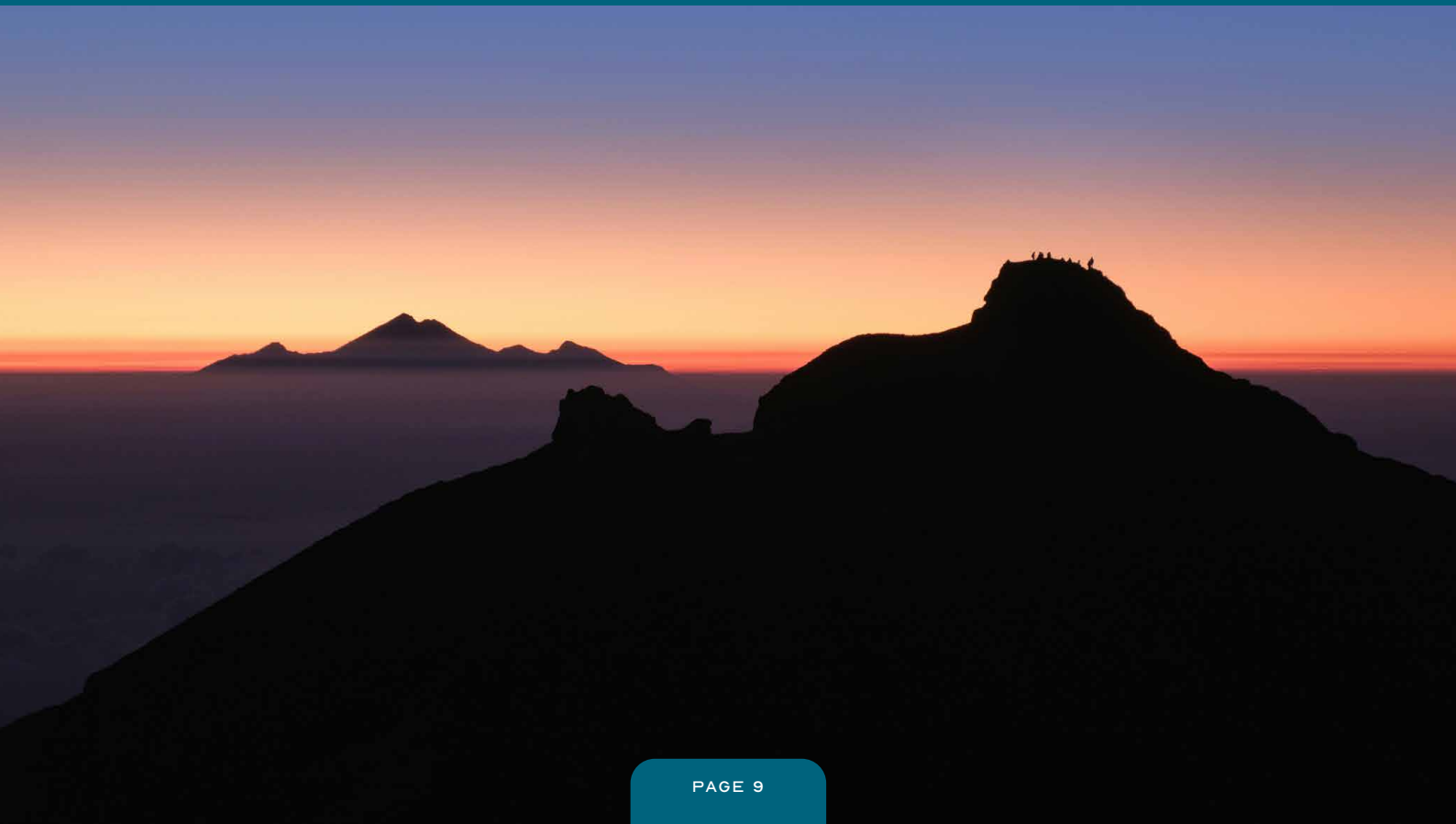

THE KIND OF PLACE WHERE A FREE
WEEKEND ENDS ON A CRATER RIM AT DAWN.

Lombok is built around a volcano. Mount Rinjani climbs to 3,726 metres, the second highest in Indonesia and a two-day trek that delivers the vast Segara Anak crater lake at sunrise. Steaming, turquoise and ringed by sheer volcanic walls, it is one of the great walks in the archipelago. This is the island's headline adventure, and it sits at the centre of everything. Close enough that the summit becomes a long weekend rather than an expedition, dramatic enough that it stays with you long after you are back on the sand.

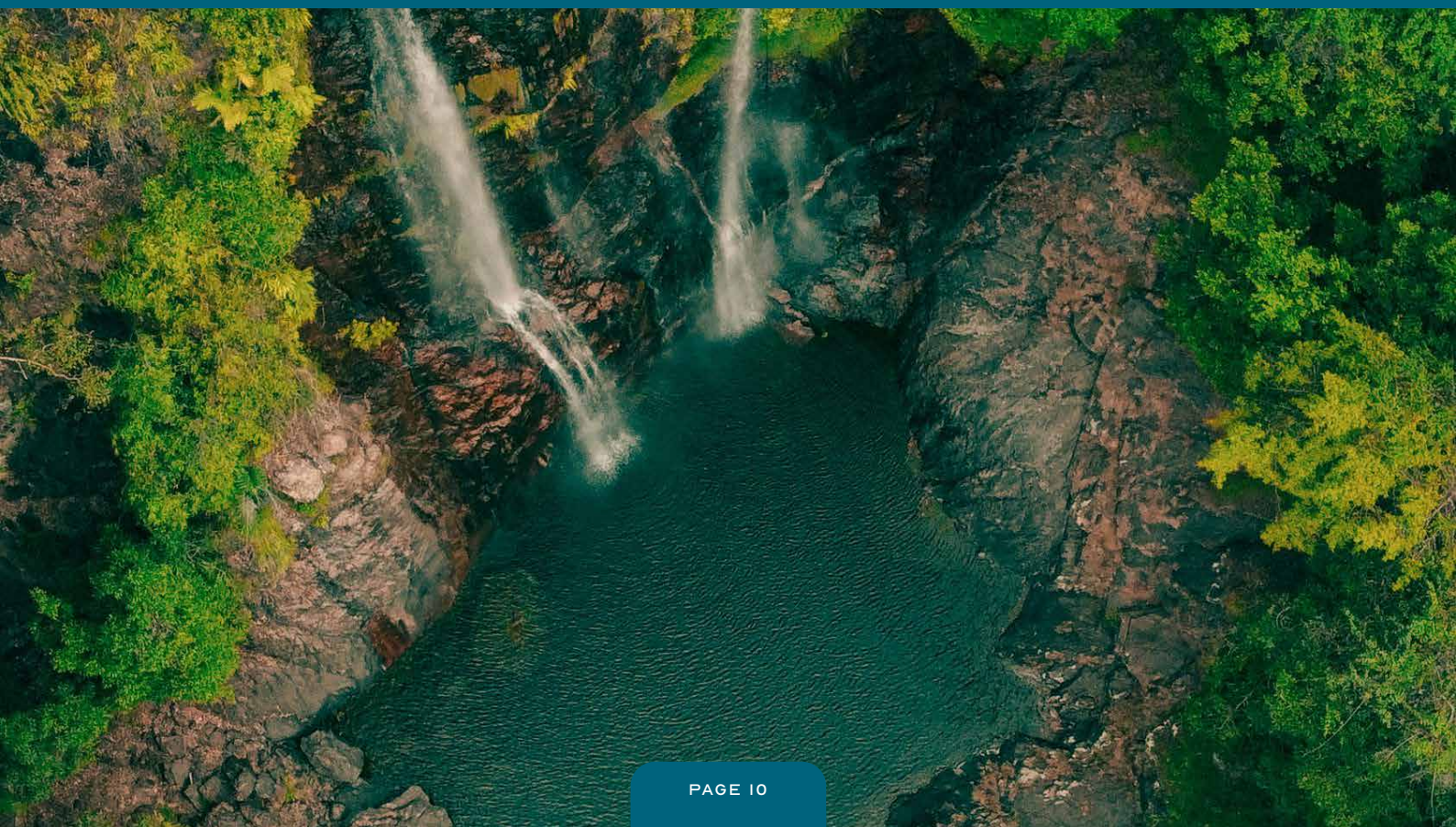




Explore Jungle Trails, Hidden Waterfalls & Rice Terraces.

TRADE THE SHORELINE FOR COOL AIR, DEEP
GREEN AND THE QUIET OF THE JUNGLE.

Step inland and the island slows down again, differently. The interior is dense and green, threaded with trails that wind past terraced paddies, river crossings and forest most visitors never reach. The twin falls at Sendang Gile and Tiu Kelep drop through the canopy into pools cool enough to swim beneath. There is a particular reward to a morning spent walking here. The air turns cooler, the noise falls away and the only thing asked of you is to keep going to the next bend. A few hours in and the rest of the world feels a very long way from the path.



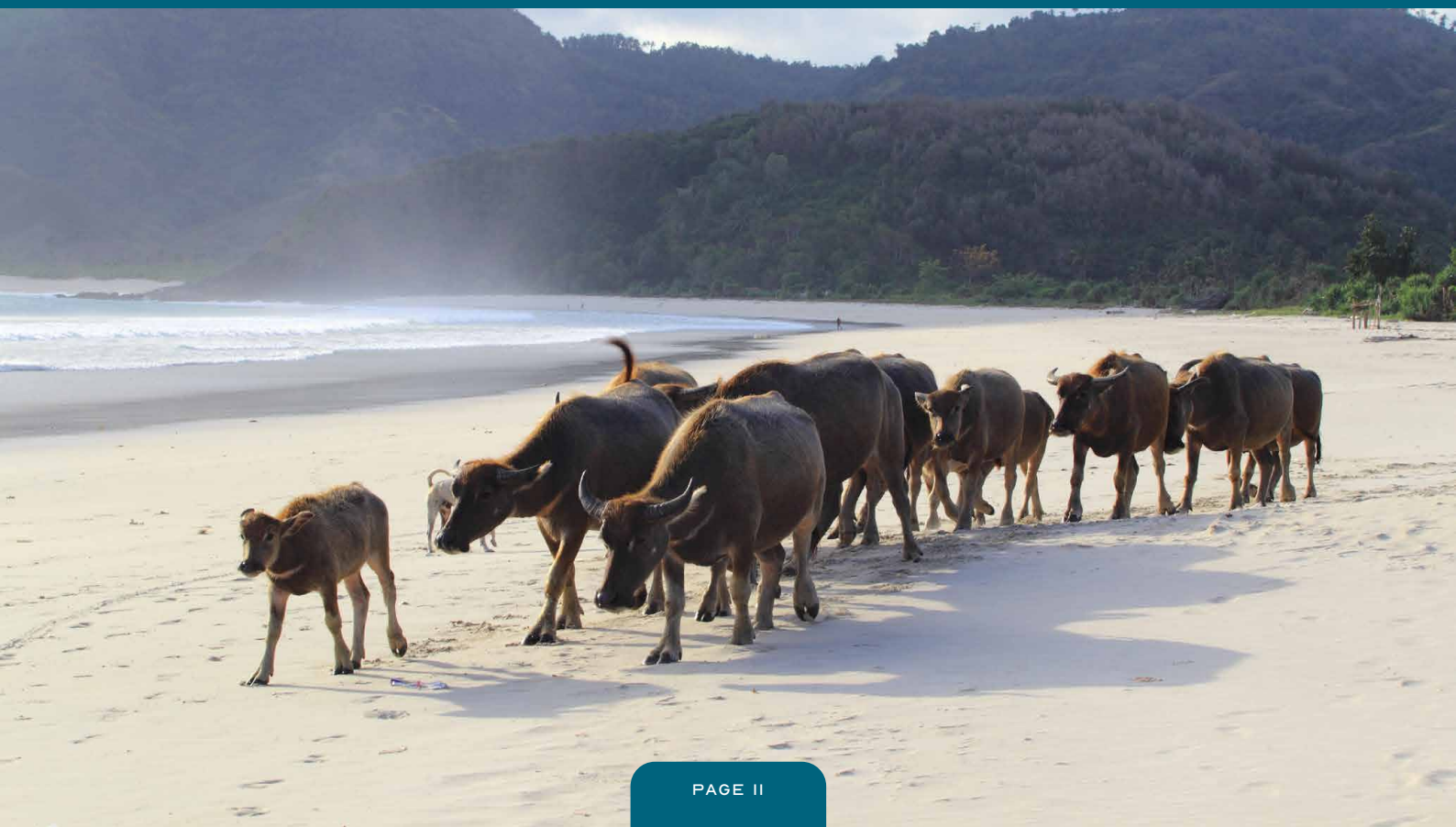


See The Island's Wildlife Up Close.

FROM CHEEKY MOUNTAIN MONKEYS TO THE BUFFALO ON SELONG BELANAK, WILDLIFE IS PART OF EVERYDAY LIFE.

Wildlife is part of daily life on Lombok. Cheeky troops of macaques gather along the forested mountain passes, water buffalo wander the pale sand at Selong Belanak as though they own it and the rare black ebony leaf monkey moves through the canopy on the slopes of Rinjani. None of it is staged. It is simply the island going about its day alongside you.

What makes it special is the geography. Lombok lies on Wallace's Line, the boundary where the wildlife of Asia gives way to that of Australia, which gives the island a birdlife found almost nowhere else. Ospreys and sea eagles over the coast, kingfishers in the forest and an abundance that rewards anyone who slows down enough to notice it.

True rest is closer than your front door. At Sanctuary Spa, the day slows the moment you arrive. Warm hands, natural oils pressed from what grows on the islands nearby and the long, unhurried rhythm of a treatment with nowhere else to be. You leave loose, light and quiet, the tension of everywhere else left somewhere behind you. Beyond the resort, Lombok rewards anyone who wants to go deeper. Yoga pavilions open to the hills, quiet retreats run by people who have practised here their whole lives and mineral hot springs steaming in the jungle. This is an island that moves slowly, and after a few days, so will you.



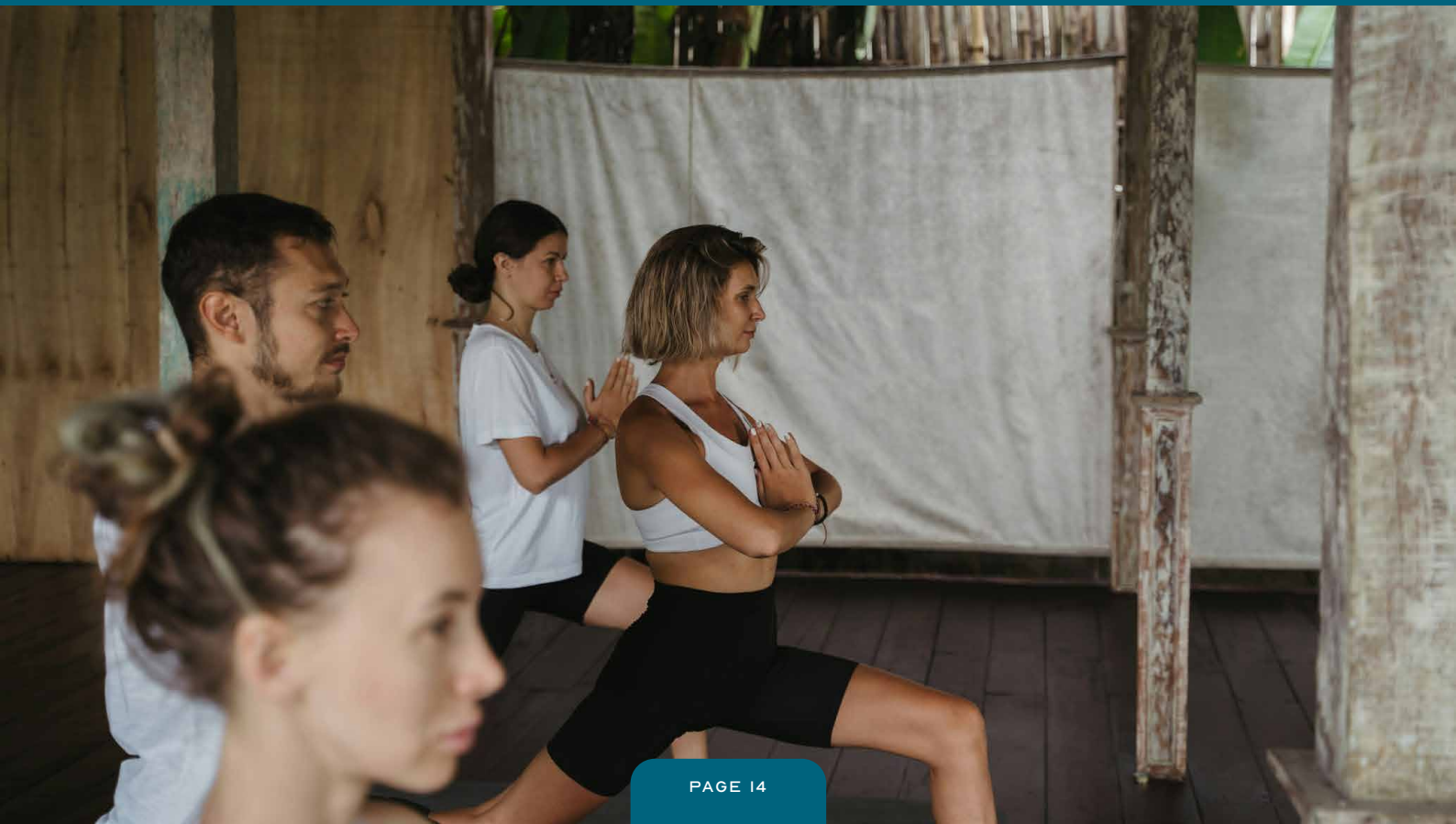

There is a reason wellness practitioners are drawn to Lombok. The mornings are silent, the air is clean and the absence of urgency does much of the work before a single session begins. Yoga at first light, meditation as the heat lifts, breathwork with nothing but birdsong in the background. Studios and retreats are scattered across the island, many led by teachers who have practised here for decades. Some are a short drive away, others worth a longer stay. All of them benefit from a setting that quiets the mind before you have even started.

STAY STRONG WITH SARAYA FITNESS ON-SITE

Keeping in form here asks nothing of you but to show up. Saraya Fitness is a proper gym, naturally lit and calm, with full strength and cardio equipment and trainers on hand whenever you want them. No commute, no crowds, no excuses. Just a good session a short walk from your door, then back to the pool before the heat sets in.

What sets it apart is the recovery. A cold plunge, a sauna and a steam room sit alongside the weights, and many come to use them just as much. Train hard in the morning, recover slowly in the afternoon and feel better by the end of a stay than you did when you arrived.

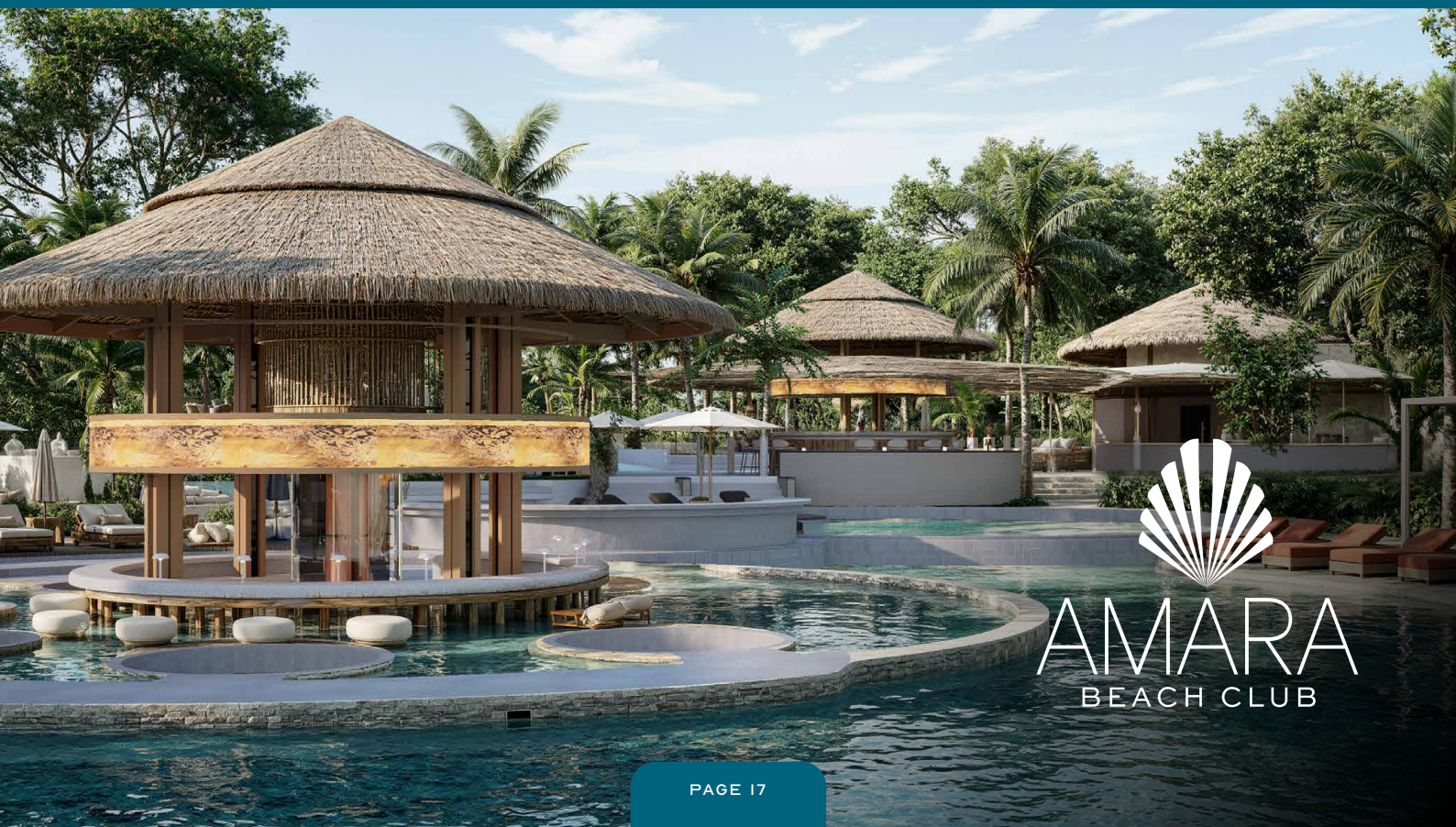


Beach Clubs, Cocktails & Sunset Bars.

The day winds down best with your feet near the sand. At Amara Beach Club, Saraya's own beachfront venue, the afternoon slides into evening over long tables, sunset menus and a drink that turns into three. Live music drifts across the sand, the light goes gold then pink and nobody is in any hurry to leave.

Beyond the resort, the island is dotted with places that do the same in their own way. The Gili Islands hold some of the most atmospheric beach clubs in Southeast Asia, open-air bars built right on the water, a short boat ride from Saraya's shore. Wherever you end up, the formula is the same. Good drinks, bare feet and the sea a few steps away.

The raw ingredients here are extraordinary. Fresh catch landed each morning by local fishermen, organic produce from growers across the island and tropical fruit at its absolute peak. It is the kind of larder most kitchens can only dream of, and a wave of ambitious new restaurants is making the most of it. Saraya's own Pavilion anchors this at home, open from breakfast through to evening with menus built on the best of each day's catch. Across the island, refined dining rooms and beachfront tables continue to open, each one adding to a food scene that grows richer by the season.



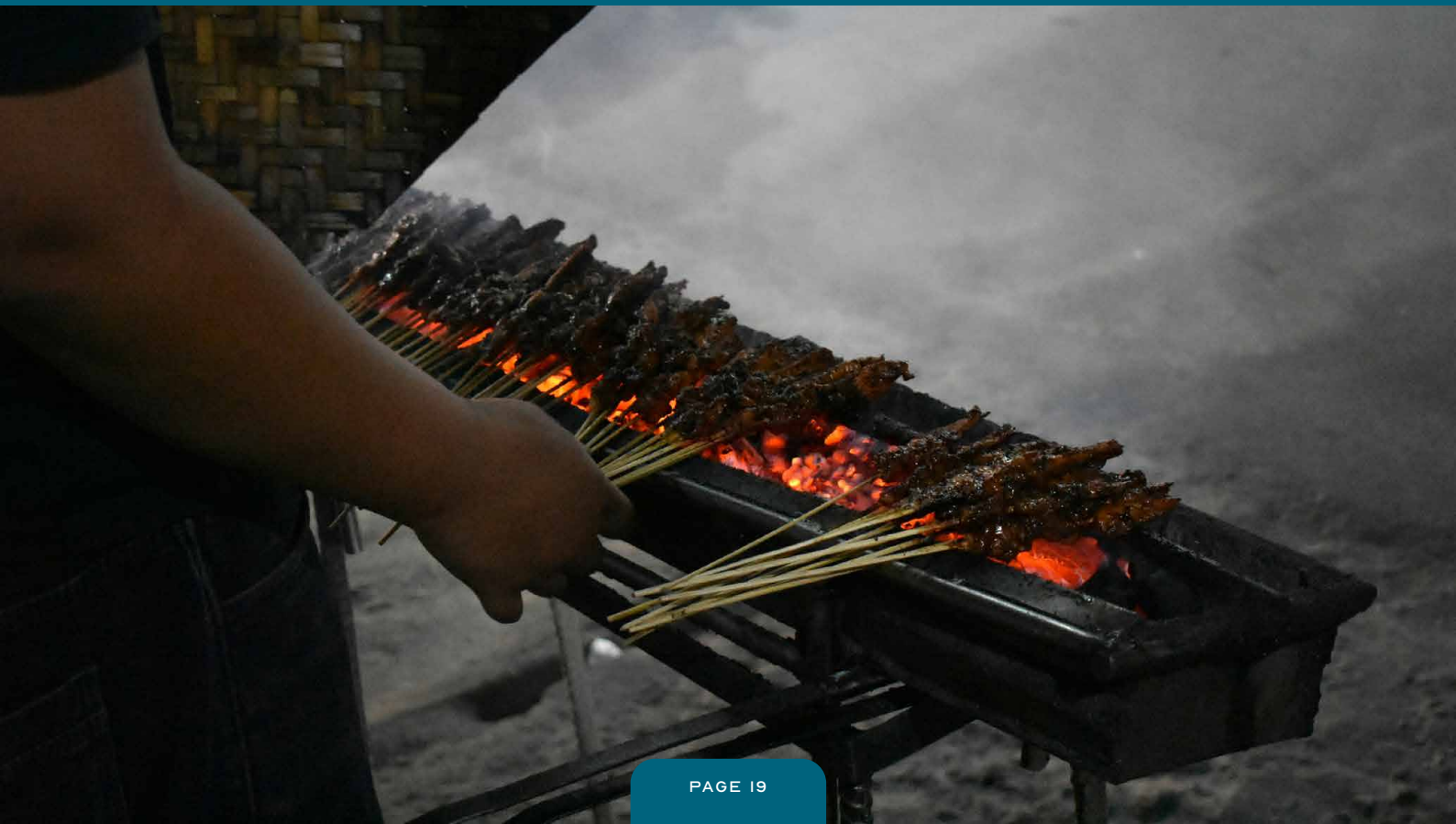

Some of the best meals in Lombok are the simplest. Grilled seafood at a plastic table on a night-market street, slow-cooked ayam taliwang, crisp peleceng kangkung and tropical fruit picked at its sweetest. This is Sasak cooking, generations deep and still the heart of how the island eats. A market tour or a guided evening out brings it within easy reach, arranged through the resort whenever you want it. Honest, vivid and rooted in a food culture that has never needed to make a fuss about itself.

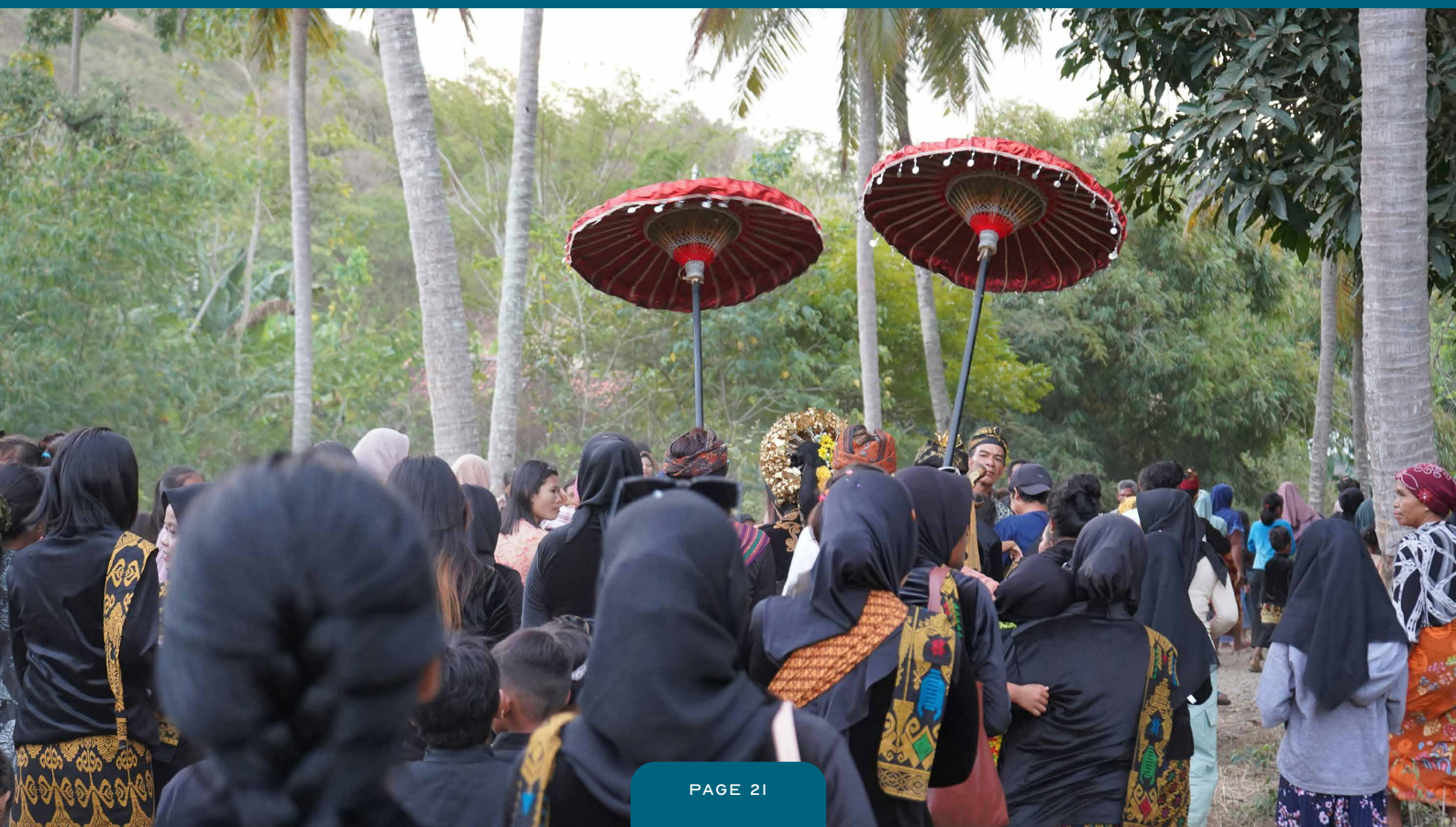

The Sasak people have shaped Lombok for centuries, and their way of life continues much as it always has. Walled villages at Sade and Ende, where homes have stood on the same foundations for generations, offer a glimpse into a tradition that has never paused for visitors. This is not heritage preserved behind glass. It is daily life, ongoing and unhurried. A guided afternoon brings it within easy reach, arranged through the resort. Time spent here has a way of recalibrating the pace of everything that follows.

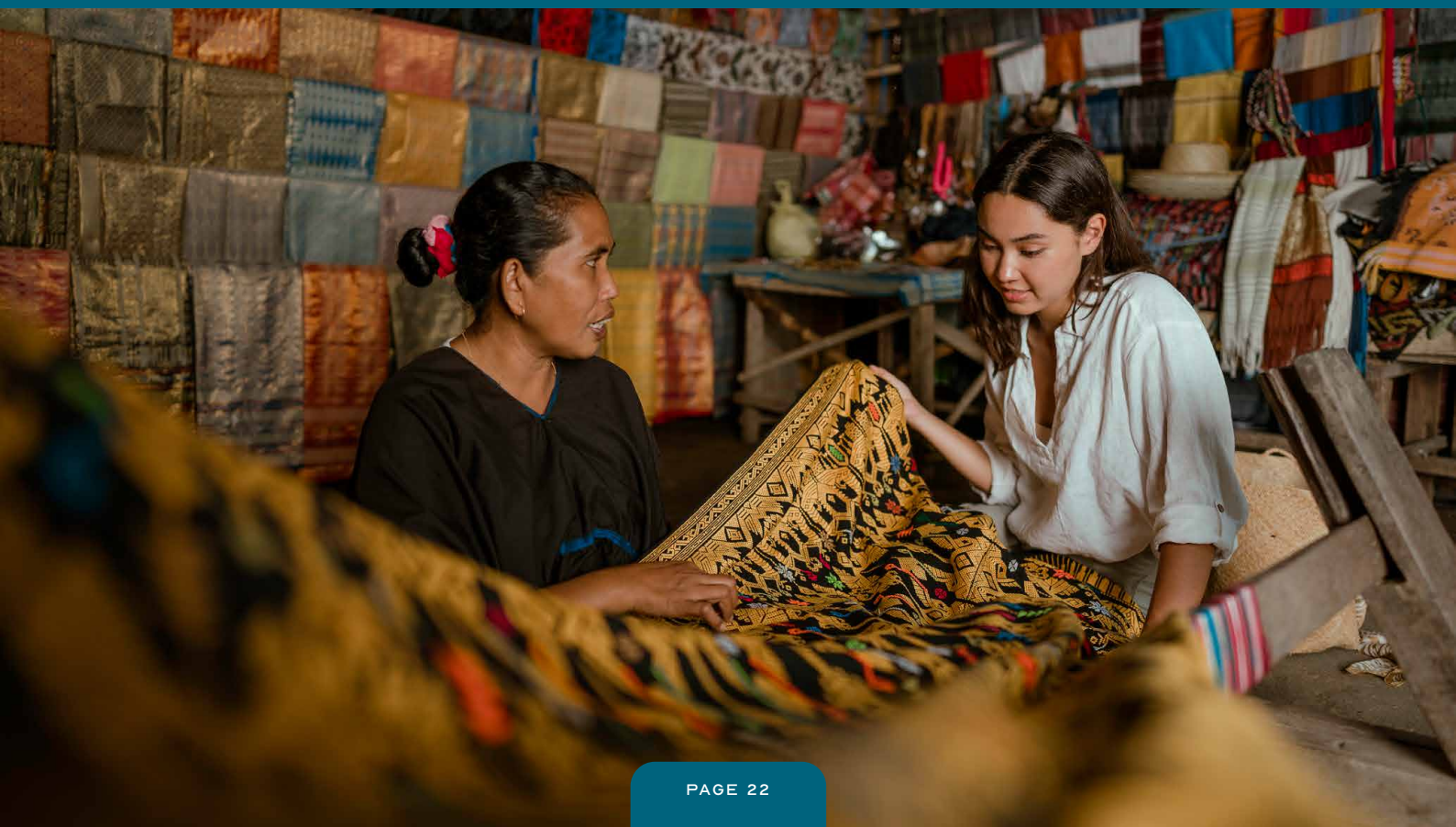




Markets, weaving & artisan crafts.

Lombok's creative life runs deep. The master weavers of Sukarara produce intricate songket textiles among the finest in the archipelago, working techniques handed down through families for generations. The island's morning markets spill over with spice, produce and the everyday rhythm of local life. A morning among the stalls or a visit to a weaving village is one of the simplest pleasures here. Vivid, genuine and entirely unstaged, the kind of encounter that stays with you far longer than the souvenir you carry home.



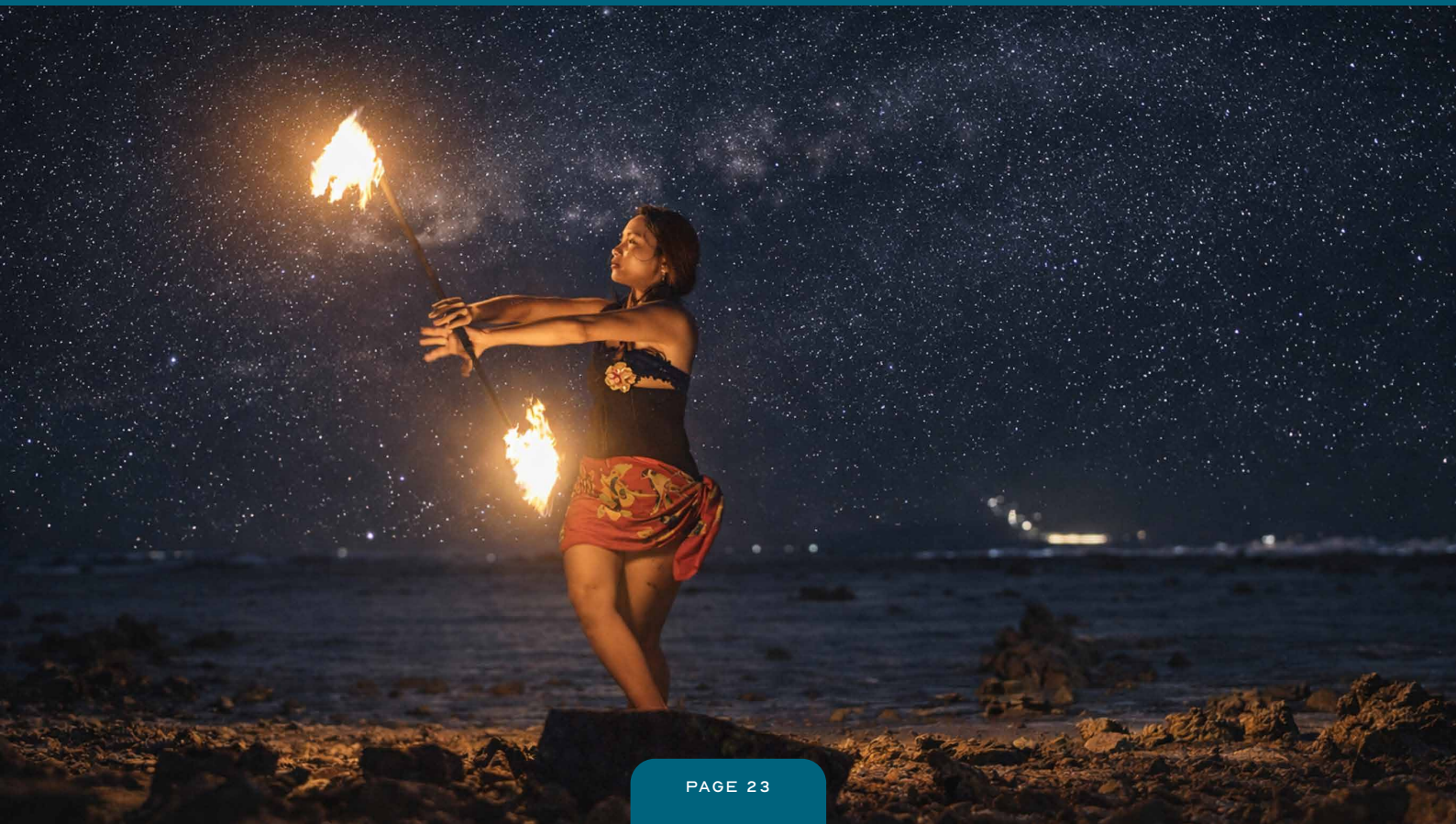


Festivals, ceremonies & island gatherings

Lombok marks time in its own way. The Bau Nyale festival draws crowds to the southern beaches each year to gather the legendary sea worms, a celebration wrapped in folklore and centuries old. 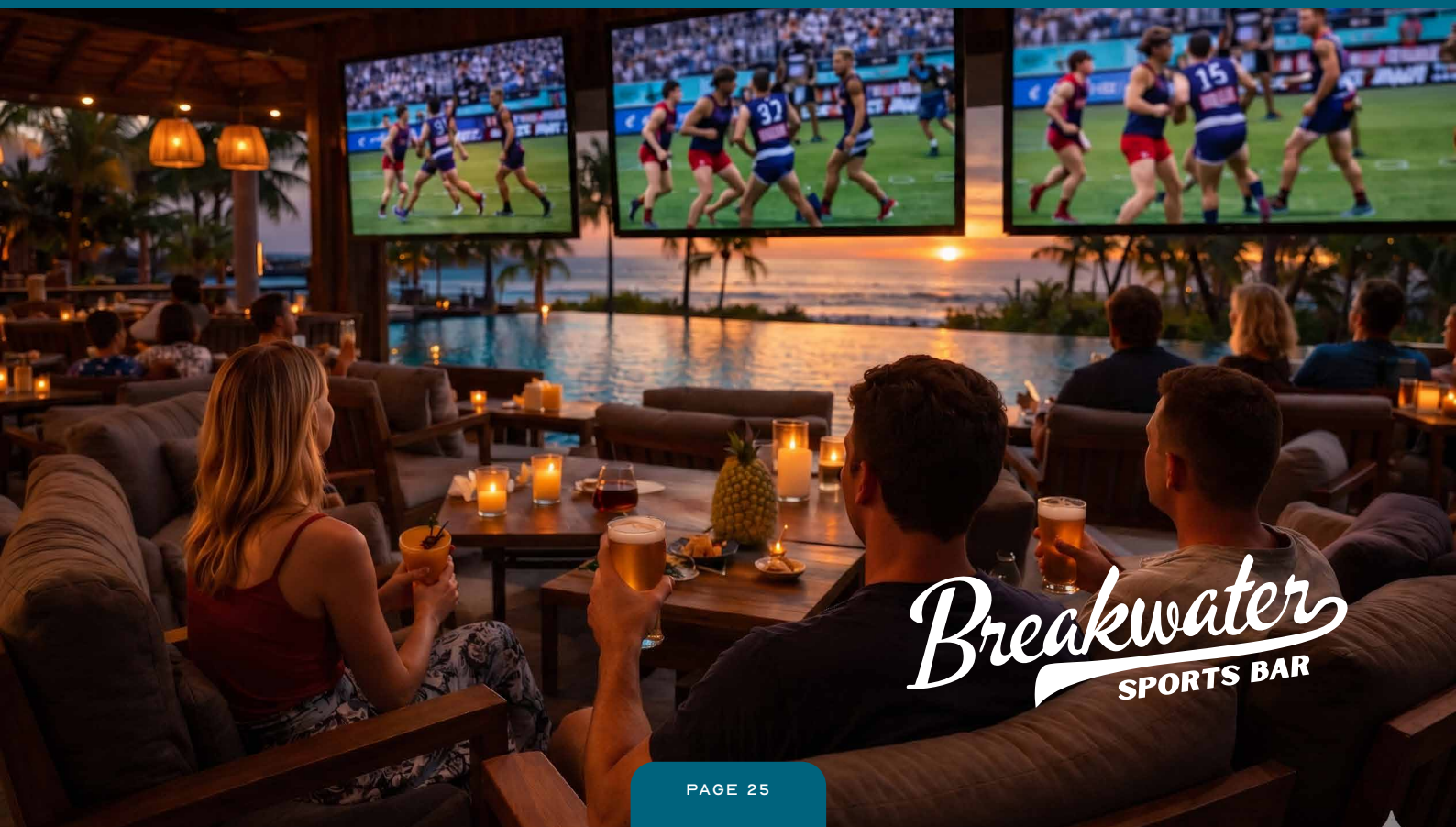

Multiple big screens carry every code that matters to a crowd from this part of the world. AFL, NRL, Rugby, the Premier League, the cricket, F1 and MotoGP. With Lombok sitting in a friendly time zone for Australian sport, the games you care about play at the hours you want them. If it is on, it is on at Breakwater.



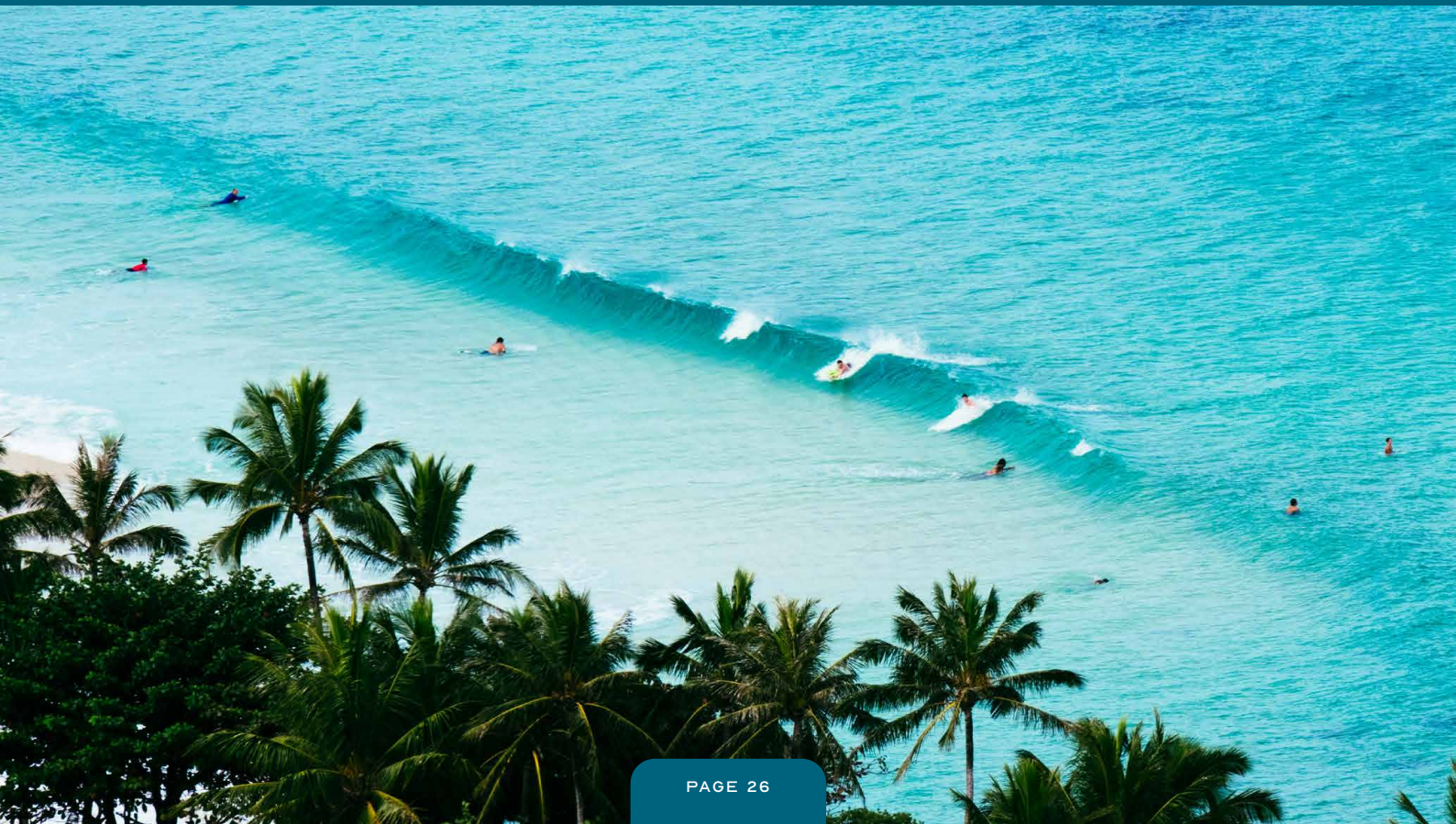


World-class surf breaks around the island.

SOME OF THE WORLDS TOP 10 BREAKS
JUST A SHORT DRIVE FROM SARAYA.

Lombok is a surfer's island. Desert Point on the south-west tip is one of the finest left-hand barrels on earth, long, hollow and rarely shared with more than a handful of surfers. It sits roughly an hour from Saraya across some of the island's most dramatic coastline.

The rest of the coast caters to everyone. The breaks around Gerupuk and Kuta run from gentle beach waves for first-timers to fast, consistent reef for the experienced. Warm water, uncrowded line-ups and a different wave for every stage of the day.





MotoGP and world-class racing at Mandalika

EVERY OCTOBER THE EYES OF THE
MOTORSPORT WORLD TURN TO LOMBOK.

Each year the Mandalika International Circuit hosts a round of the MotoGP world championship, drawing hundreds of thousands of fans to the island's south coast. For one weekend Lombok runs on a different current. The grandstands fill, the paddock comes alive and a corner of Indonesia that trades on its quiet becomes one of the loudest places in world sport.

It is more than a single weekend, too. The World Superbike Championship races here and the calendar deepens each season. From Saraya it is a forty-minute drive to the circuit, close enough to go for the day and be back at the beach by evening.
